The following ethical guidelines must be followed by the Author(s), Reviewers and Editor(s) involved in publishing an article in IJCPRR.

- The authors are requested to present the data and results which are reproducible.
- Author(s) are requested to provide the spectroscopic evidences as supporting info.
- Authors are requested to cite the others work as reference.
- The author should also put the other's contribution in acknowledgement.
- The corresponding author is responsible for all correspondence to the Editor.
- The same manuscript should not be submitted to several journals for publication unless it is rejected or withdrawn from IJCPRR.
- Plagiarism is not allowed in IJCPRR journal. Authors are requested not to copy the text or result of other's work.
- The funding agencies must be reported in the acknowledgement section.
- If any fraudulent data, plagiarism or infringement of professional ethical codes found in future even after publication, the article will be removed from the archive.
- The editor of IJCPRR has sole responsibility to accept a submitted paper or to reject it after proper peer-review.
- The Editorial board members are requested to give suggestions and take necessary steps to improve the standard of the journal.
